sinus syndrome, patients with second- or third-degree AV
block ,patients with hypotension (less than 90 mm Hg
systolic), hypersensitivity to the drug, and Patients with
acute myocardial infarction and pulmonary congestion
documented by x-ray on admission. **DRUG INTERACTIONS:**
Lithium: increased risk of neurotoxicity,Nitrate derivative:
Increased hypotensive effects and faintness.Alpha-
antagonists:Increased antihypertensive effects. Amiodarone,
digoxin:Increased risk of bradycardia,Beta-blockers:
Possibility of rhythm disturbances, Other antiarrhythmic
agents: increased risk of heart block,Ciclosporin:Increase
