PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES:

MECHANISM OF ACTION: Luliconazole is an antifungal that belongs to the azole class. Although the exact mechanism of action against dermatophytes is unknown, luliconazole appears to inhibit ergosterol synthesis by inhibiting the enzyme lanosterol demethylase. Inhibition of this enzyme's activity by azoles results in decreased amounts of ergosterol, a constituent of fungal cell membranes, and a corresponding accumulation of lanosterol. **Mechanism of Resistance:** Luliconazole cream 1%w/w has been shown to be active against most isolates of the fungi, both *Trichophyton rubrum*, *Epidermophyton floccosum*.

INDICATIONS: For the treatment of cutaneous mycosis viz. *Tinea pedis*, *Tinea corporis*, *Tinea cruris*.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: For the treatment of interdigital *tinea pedis* (athlete's foot that is between the toes) Adults: Apply a thin layer of cream topically to affected areas, and approximately 1 inch of the immediate surrounding areas, once daily for 2 weeks. Children and Adolescents 12 to 17 years: Apply a thin layer of cream topically to affected areas, and approximately 1 inch of the immediate surrounding areas, once daily for 2 weeks. For the treatment of *tinea cruris* (jock itch or ringworm) and *tinea corporis* (Ringworm of body): Adults: Apply topically to affected areas, and approximately 1 inch of the immediate surrounding areas, once daily for 1 week. Children and Adolescents 12 to 17 years: Apply topically to affected areas, and approximately 1 inch of the immediate surrounding areas, once daily for 1 week. Method of administration For Topical Use Only, Not for Ophthalmic, oral, or Intravaginal use.

CONTRAINDICATION: None.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: It is for external use only. Do not let cream get into your eyes, nose, or mouth, other mucous membranes and do not swallow it.

DRUG INTERACTIONS: Not known.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: It may cause moderate skin reactions at the treatment site, contact dermatitis, mild: skin irritation may happen.
